# PREFACE

The first year Pre Clinical curriculum comprises of “Human Anatomy”, “Physiology”, “Biochemistry” and “Introduction to Community Medicine”.

It is divided into two Semester of 6 month duration each.

At the end of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester internal assessment both in theory and practical in each subject are held, as well as a pre University examination is conducted before the 1<sup>st</sup> Professional University examination at the completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

For qualifying to appear in the Professional University examination 75% attendance both in theory and practical is required, 35% marks in internal assessments.

The pass marks in the University Professional examination is 50% in theory and practical separately.

The syllabus describes the goals, aims, objectives, learning schedule in various topics of each subject’s essential and recommended books, and fulfilling number of teaching hours, and the course material as per MCI rules and guidelines.
