



RESEARCH AND ACADEMIC ACTIVITY MAYO INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES, GADIA, BARABANKI.

Academic year 2017-18.

1. Organized a Symposium on **NOSOCOMIAL INFECTIONS - RECENT TRENDS IN THE MANAGEMENT**” on 29TH APRIL 2017 at Mayo Institute of Medical Sciences, Gadia, Barabanki and invited Dr T.N.Dhole – HOD, Department of Microbiology, SGPGI, Lucknow and Dr Afzal Azim, Professor Department of Critical care Medicine, SGPGI, Lucknow do deliver lectures on the topic. Programme was attended by more than 125 registered delegates (both faculty and students) of the Institute.
2. A CME Programme was organized on **ATTITUDE AND COMMUNICATION, MEDICAL RESEARCH, AND SOFT SKILL FOR MEDICAL PROFESSION** and invited three faculty from KGMU-Lucknow - Dr Apul Goel, Professor - Department of Urology, Dr Anuradha Nischal – Professor, Department of Pharmacology and Dr. Riddhi Jaiswal – Associate Professor, Department of Pathology to deliver their lectures on 31ST May 2017. Programme was attended by more than 125 registered delegates (both faculty and students) of the Institute.
