## Admissions Procedure

### MD/MS Programme

The Institute aims to produce competent Post Graduate Specialists and Medical teachers who shall recognize the health needs of the community and carry out professional obligation ethically and in keeping with the objectives of the national health policy.

The Postgraduate program is of 3 years duration in a specialty, aiming at development of specific competencies through theoretical knowledge, Practical and clinical skills, Thesis skills, Attitudes including communication skills, Training in research methodology. –

### Admission Criteria

All the seats are allotted as per the merit secured in PG-NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST. (PG-NEET)

### Duration

Total duration of the program is 36 months divided over 6 semester of six months each followed by one year compulsory Senior Residentship & 1 Year Service as Assistance Professor from Mayo Institute of Medical Sciences, Barabanki

### Eligibility (As per PG NEET Criteria)

As per PG-National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test. (PG-NEET 2020)

### Educational Qualification

Candidates in possession of MBBS Degree or Provisional MBBS Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the Medical Council of India or State Medical Council and have completed one year of internship or are likely to complete the internship on or before 31 March 2020. Indian citizens or overseas citizens of India who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) which is conducted by National Board of Examinations. Further, they should have been registered with MCI/SMC and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before 31.03.2020. Foreign Medical Graduates are required to bring their FMGE Pass certificate issued by NBE on their Testing Day
